**1 Tic Tac Toe Activity**

Items Required:  
Tic Tac Toe template  
Pencil  
2 sets of coloured counters - 5 of each colour

Instructions:  
Print out Tic Tac Toe template.  
Write sight words in the squares.  
Give each player 5 coloured counters.  
Players take turns to say a sight word and cover the word with a counter.  
First to cover three words in a row wins.

Suggestion:  
Use buttons, bottle lids or lego blocks as counters.

**2 Water Spray Activity**

Items Required:  
Water spray bottle  
Chalk  
Fence, wall or path

Instructions:  
Write sight words with chalk on fence, wall or path outside.  
Ask child to spray each sight word as they say the word.

Alternative:  
Use a wet sponge to throw at sight words.

Items Required:

Instructions:  
Print and cut out individual eggs.  
Write sight words on the eggs.  
Place eggs on a table.  
Ask child to flip eggs with the spatula and say the sight word as they flip each word.

**4 Spotlight Activity**

Items Required:  
Paper or card  
Pencil  
Blu-tack or tape  
Torch

Instructions:  
Write out sight words on individual pieces of paper or card.  
Blu-tack or tape words to a wall.  
Turn out lights or shut curtains to darken the room.  
Ask child to shine the torchlight on a sight word and say what the word is.

Alternatives:  
Write words on a blackboard or whiteboard.  
Place sight word cards on the floor.

**5 Chatterbox Activity**

Items Required:  
Chatterbox template  
Scissors  
Pencil

Instructions:  
Print and cut out Chatterbox template.  
Write sight words on the spaces, arrows indicate which direction to write, ie ↑ for  
Follow instructions for folding the chatterbox.  
Child asks someone to choose a sight word.  
Child spells the sight word whilst moving the chatterbox. Repeat this for a sight word inside the chatterbox.  
Someone chooses a sight word inside the chatterbox. Child reads the joke inside the corresponding flap.

Child can call out a sight word they know and swat the fly with the matching word.  
Child can use their hand to swat the flies.

Suggestions:

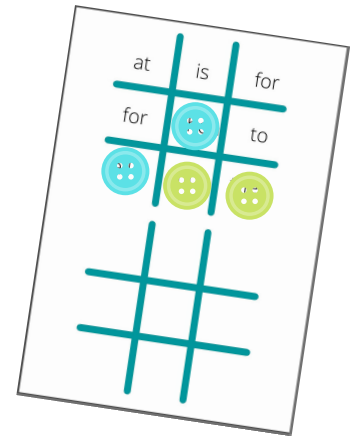

Write sight words in the squares.

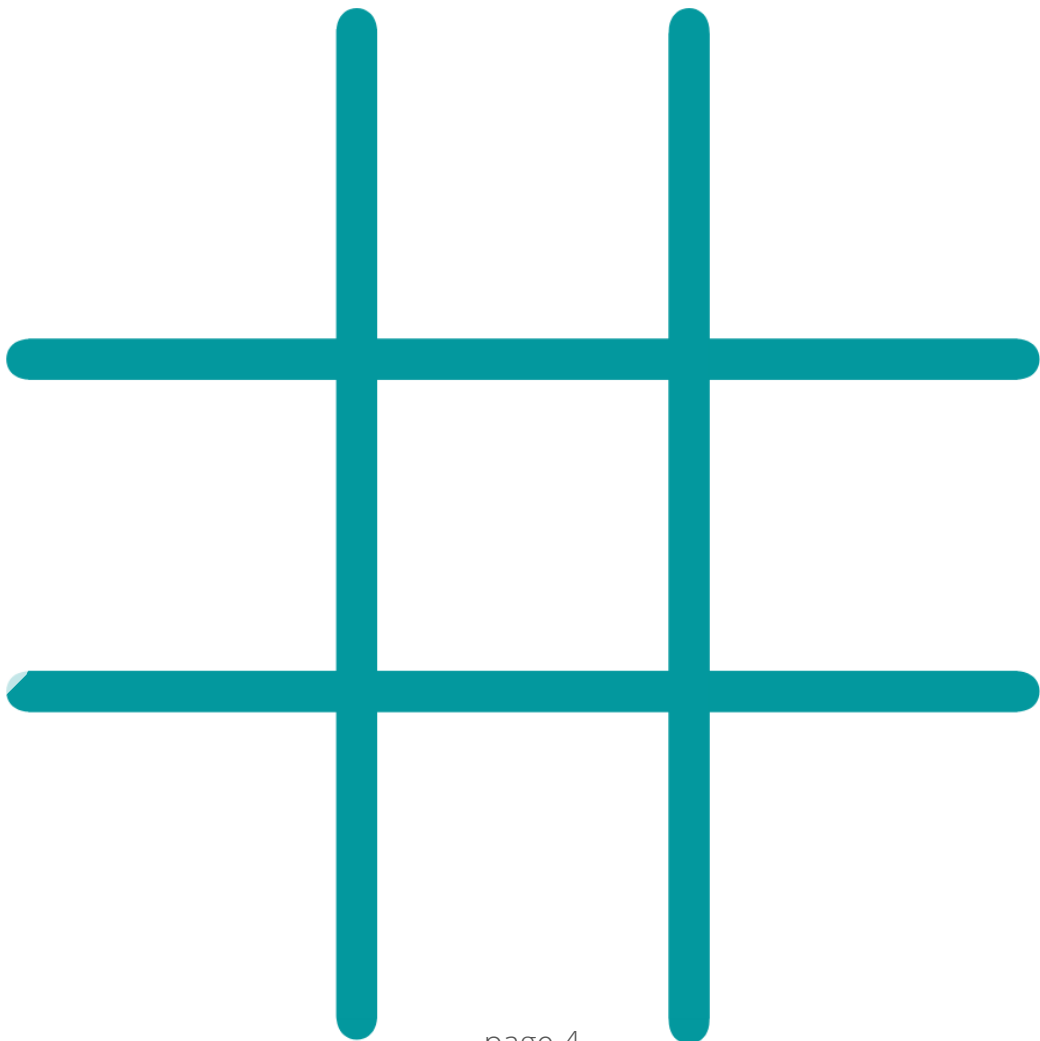
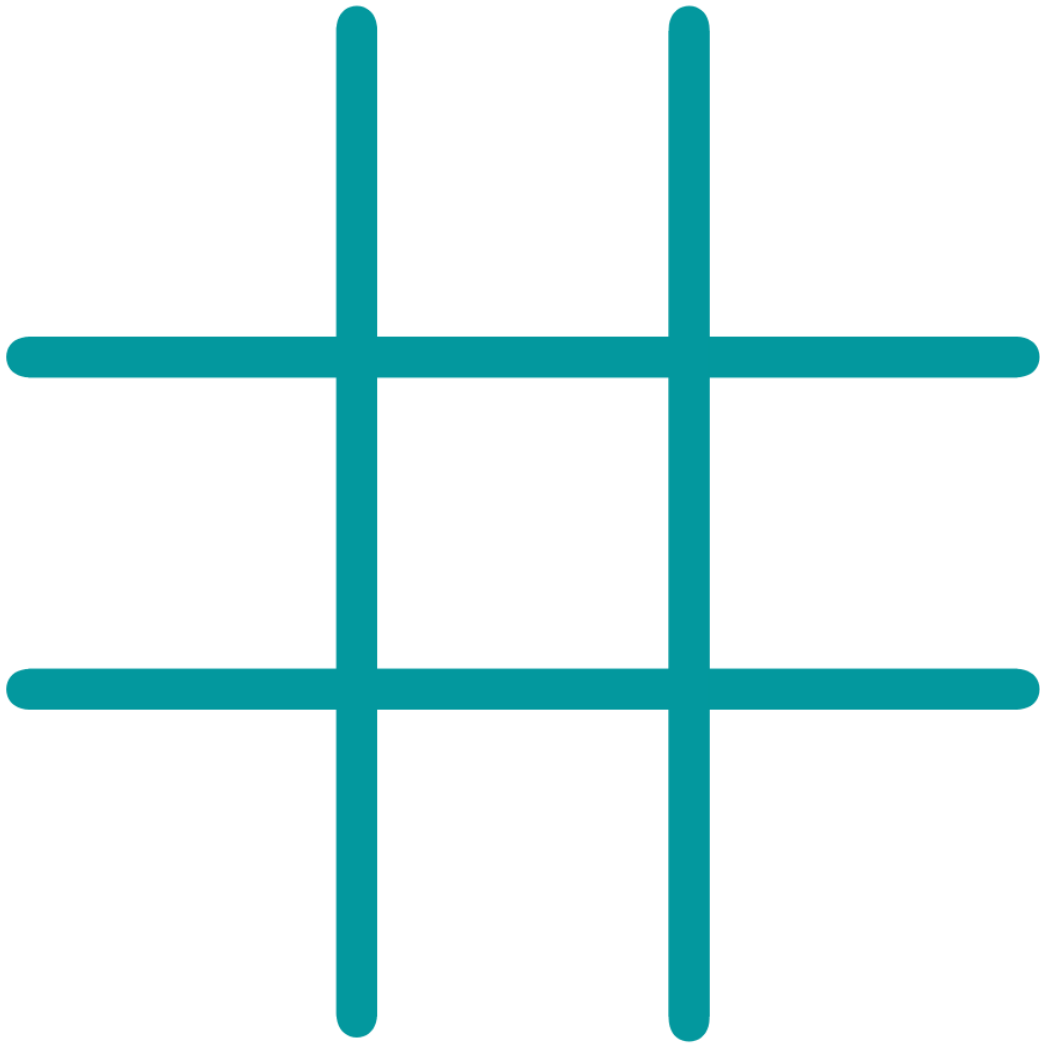
Give each player 5 coloured counters.

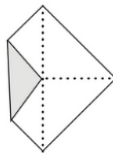
# How to make your Chatterbox



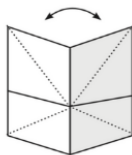
Cut out square. Fold each corner to the opposite corner. Unfold paper.



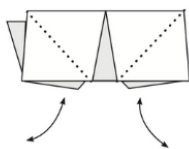
Turn paper face down and fold all corners into the centre.



Turn paper over so all folds are face down. Fold all corners to the centre.



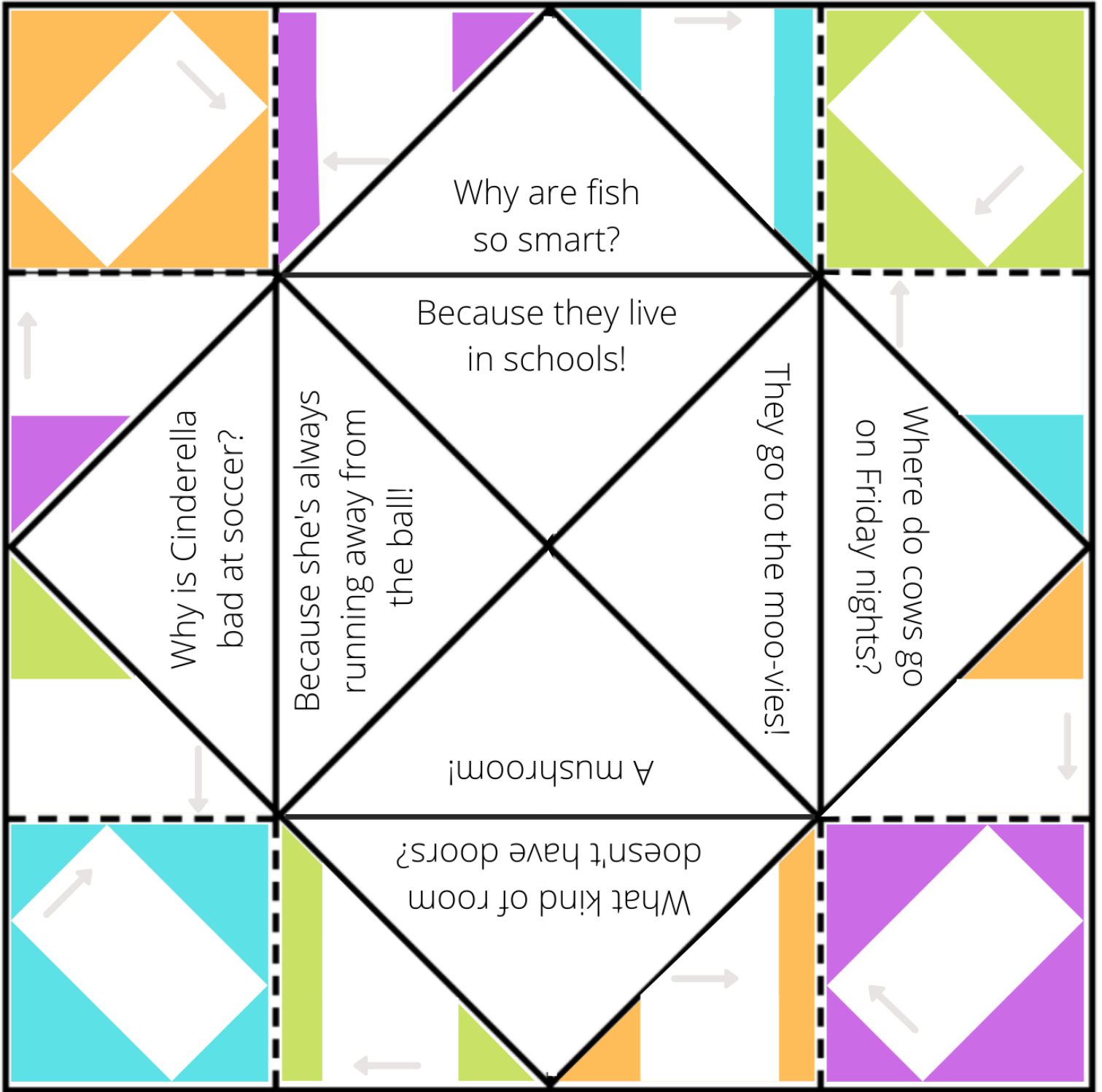
Fold the paper in half vertically and then open flat.

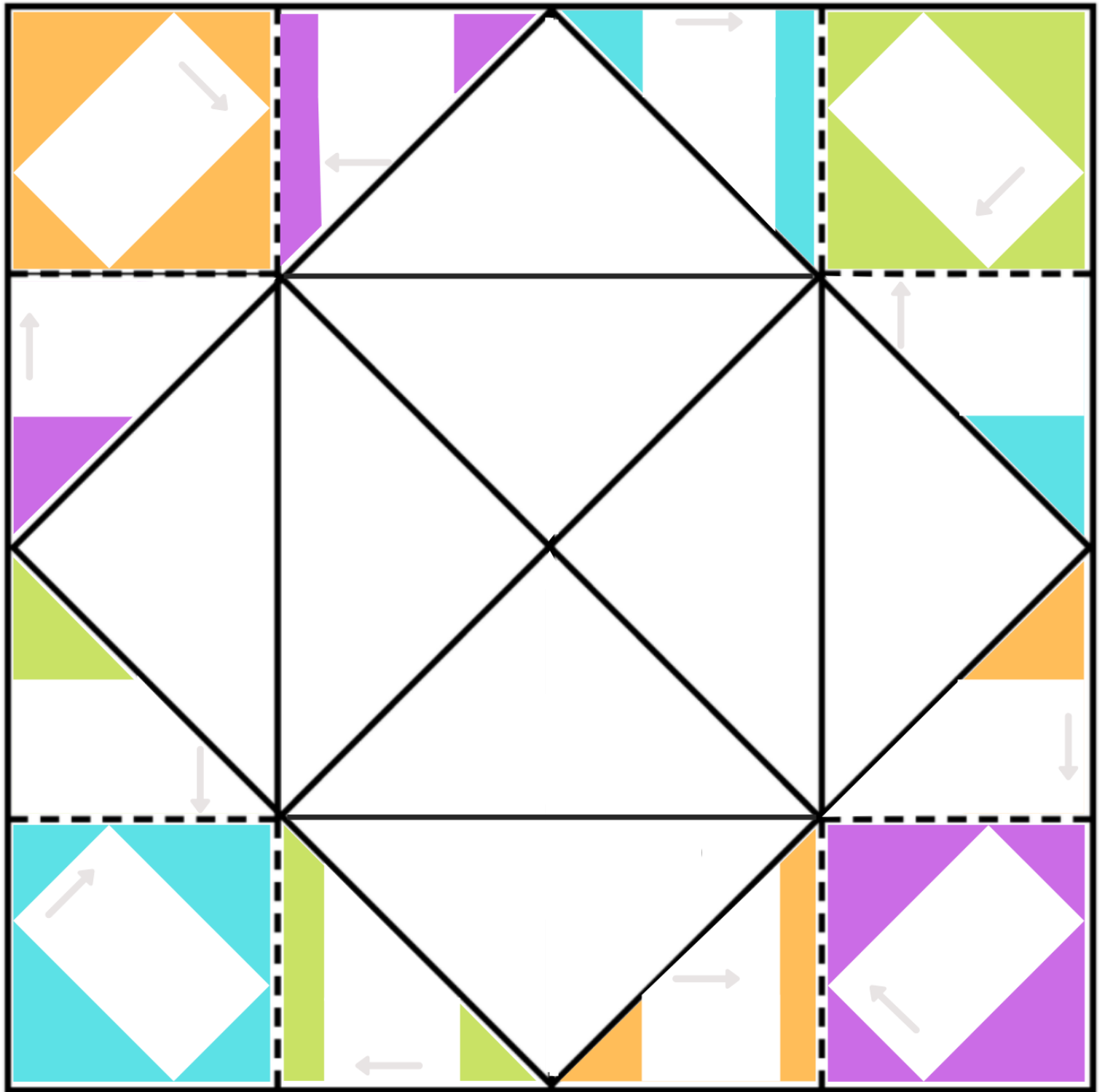


Fold the paper in half horizontally. Place thumbs and forefingers into four corners of the chatterbox.



Your chatterbox is ready to use.

Print and cut out flies template.

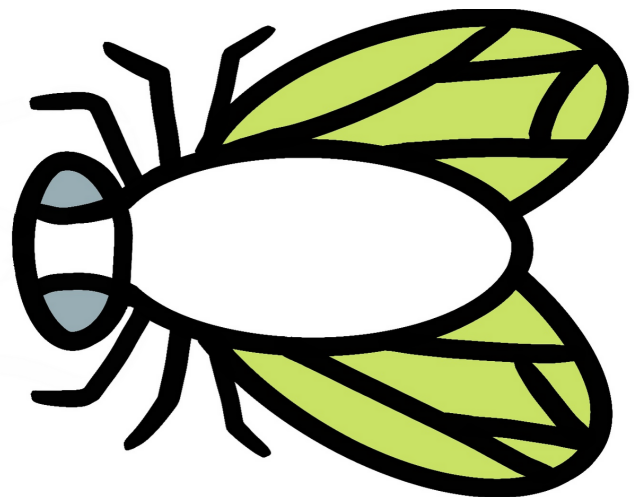
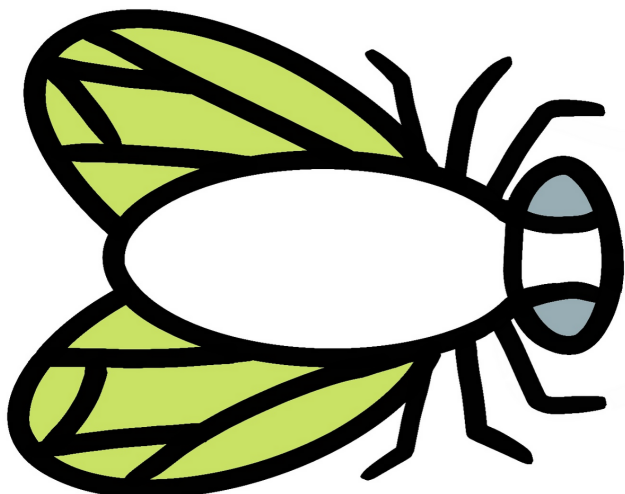
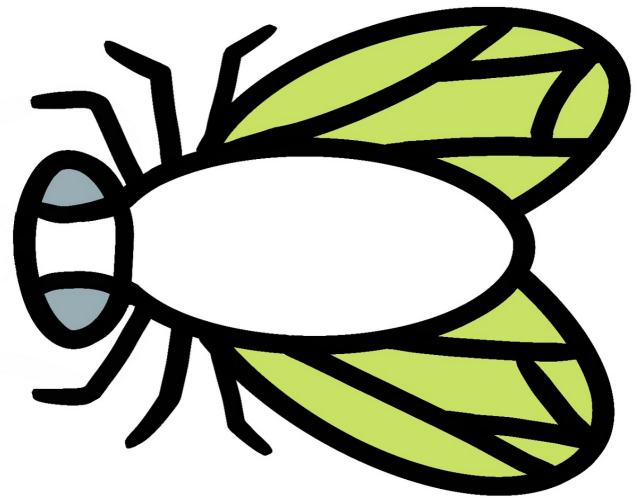
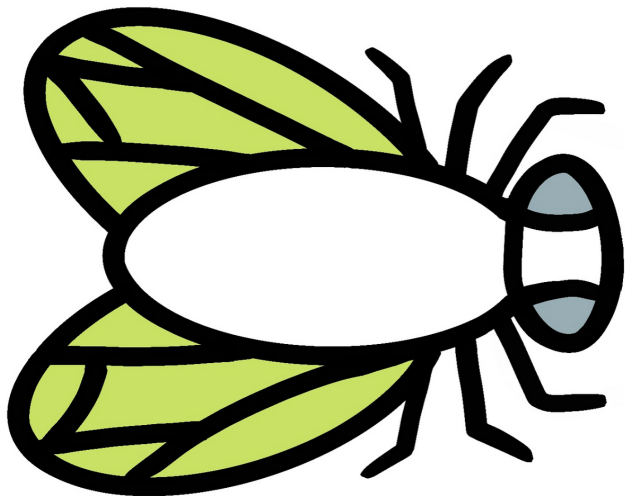
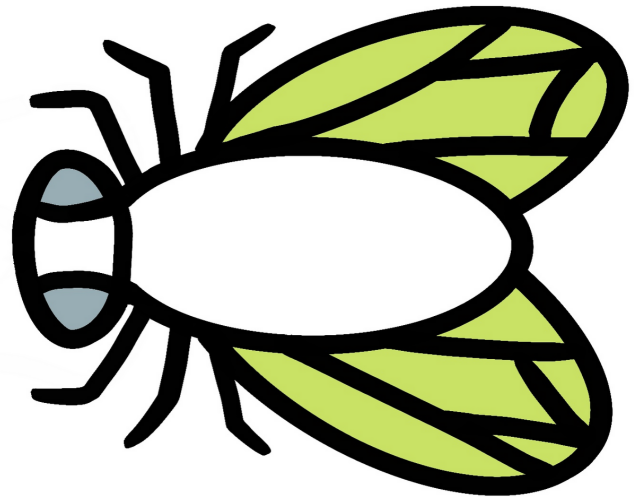
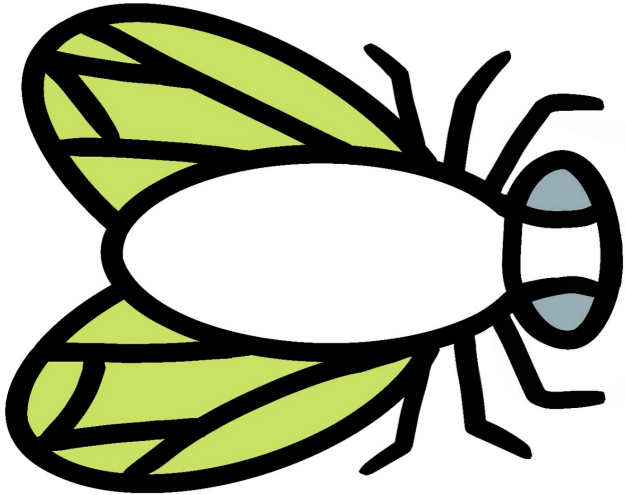
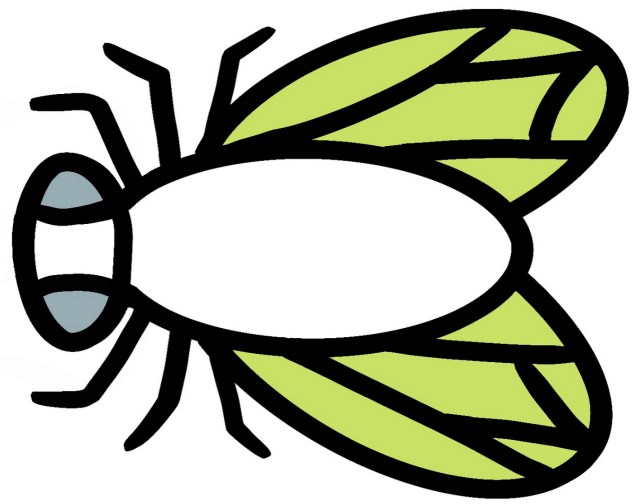
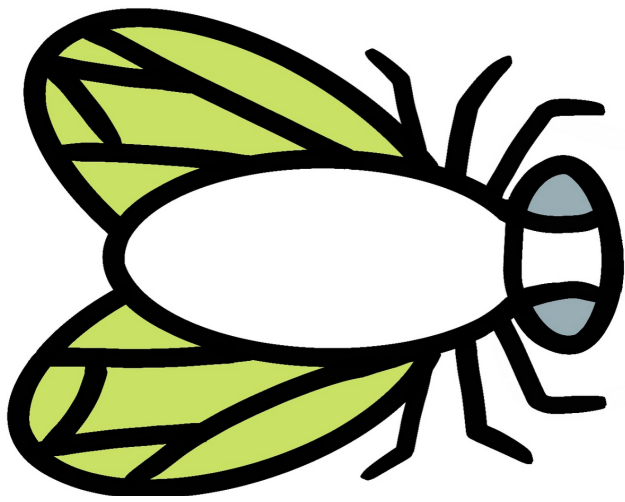
